Updates...

Ongoing Construction Update | The remaining roof projects include the Adoration Chapel, St. Jude Grotto, and both sheds. Those will be completed in the next couple of weeks.

The project will then shift to the interior damage impacting the Family Center, Church, Offices, and Rectory. While Hurricane Ida is the culprit, I have decided, with the support of the Christ the Redeemer Finance Council and administrative staff and the diocese administration, to include additional upgrades to run concurrently with the hurricane repairs. This will allow our campus to operate without disruption for longer and assure the stability of our parish grounds.

Our focus will be first on the Family Center. Repairs include flooring, ceiling, painting, plumbing, HVAC, electrical, and lighting. Some of these repairs will restore us to the precious renovation, and some will go beyond. I am excited to have this critical building opened to us again. Once the Family Center has been completely restored the project will move to the church, offices, and rectory. The Family Center will operate as the church, office, and meeting hall during this period. Please be patient.

Our property insurance and FEMA claims will fund the hurricane damage repairs; however, the additional focus areas will be funded through Christ the Redeemer. I am currently exploring funding options to be prudent with our resources and to practice good stewardship. This entire project is being designed and developed by GFP, a local architectural firm. The interior portion of the project is expected to go out for public bid within the next week. Once a contractor is identified the project will begin to take shape. I will provide you with more details as they develop. Please pray for all involved with this undertaking. Thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.

Thus far we have completed the roofing project on the Family Center and the Church, and the awning at the Family Center has been installed.
