LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the Scriptures, God speaks to us, his people, in inspired words, opening to us the mystery of redemption and salvation and offering us spiritual nourishment. Christ himself is present in the midst of the faithful through his Word. As we are fed by the Word of God, we sit in attentive silence or offer our voices in song in full participation. We stand for the Gospel, showing great reverence for Jesus Christ present there, and finally we affirm the faith we have in the Creed before offering up our hearts to the Lord in our Universal Prayers.

Early in the morning Moses went up Mount Sinai as the LORD had commanded him, taking along the two stone tablets. Having come down in a cloud, the LORD stood with Moses there and proclaimed his name, "LORD." HOMILY NOTES

PASTORAL REFLECTION

The model of love that the Trinity shows us is a gift, one that can teach us every day how to love better. The Father pours himself out in love to the Son, who in turn pours himself out in love to the Father. This mutual exchange of love is the Holy Spirit, meaning that the love of the Father for the Son and the Son for the Father is so constant and powerful that it constitutes the third Person of the Trinity. That is the kind of love we can give! We can pour ourselves out for others, and in turn be filled by their love, and by the love of God! Our love can become solid and strong when we give all of ourselves. Our gift of self can be a roaring fire of love, or a soft wind brushing through the heart of another. We can then glory in those we love, weep as they weep, and rejoice as they rejoice. We can exchange with constant strength the love, knowledge, and power of our lives.

“The Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth. He will not speak on his own, but he will speak what he hears, and will declare to you the things that are coming. He will glorify me, because he will take from what is mine and declare it to you. Everything that the Father has is mine; for this reason I told you that he will take from what is mine and declare it to you.”

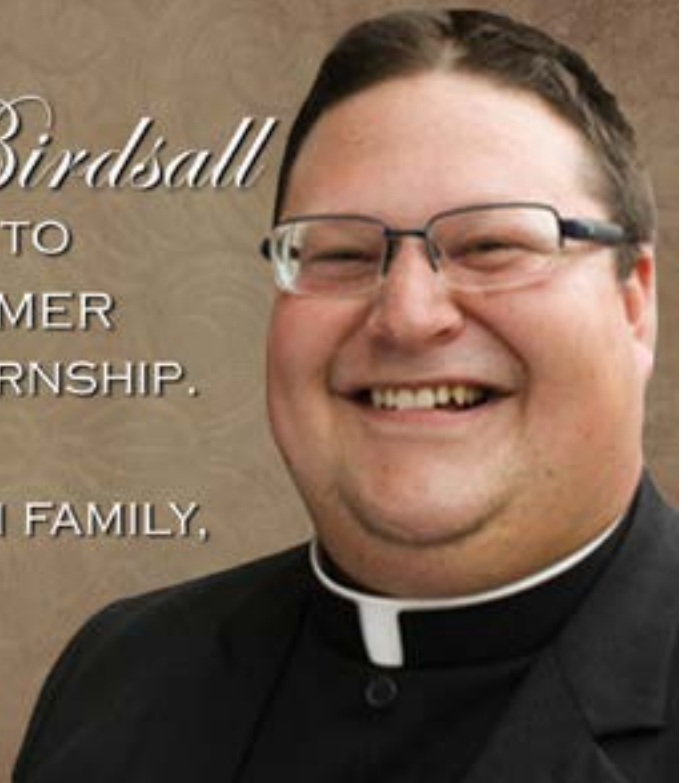
