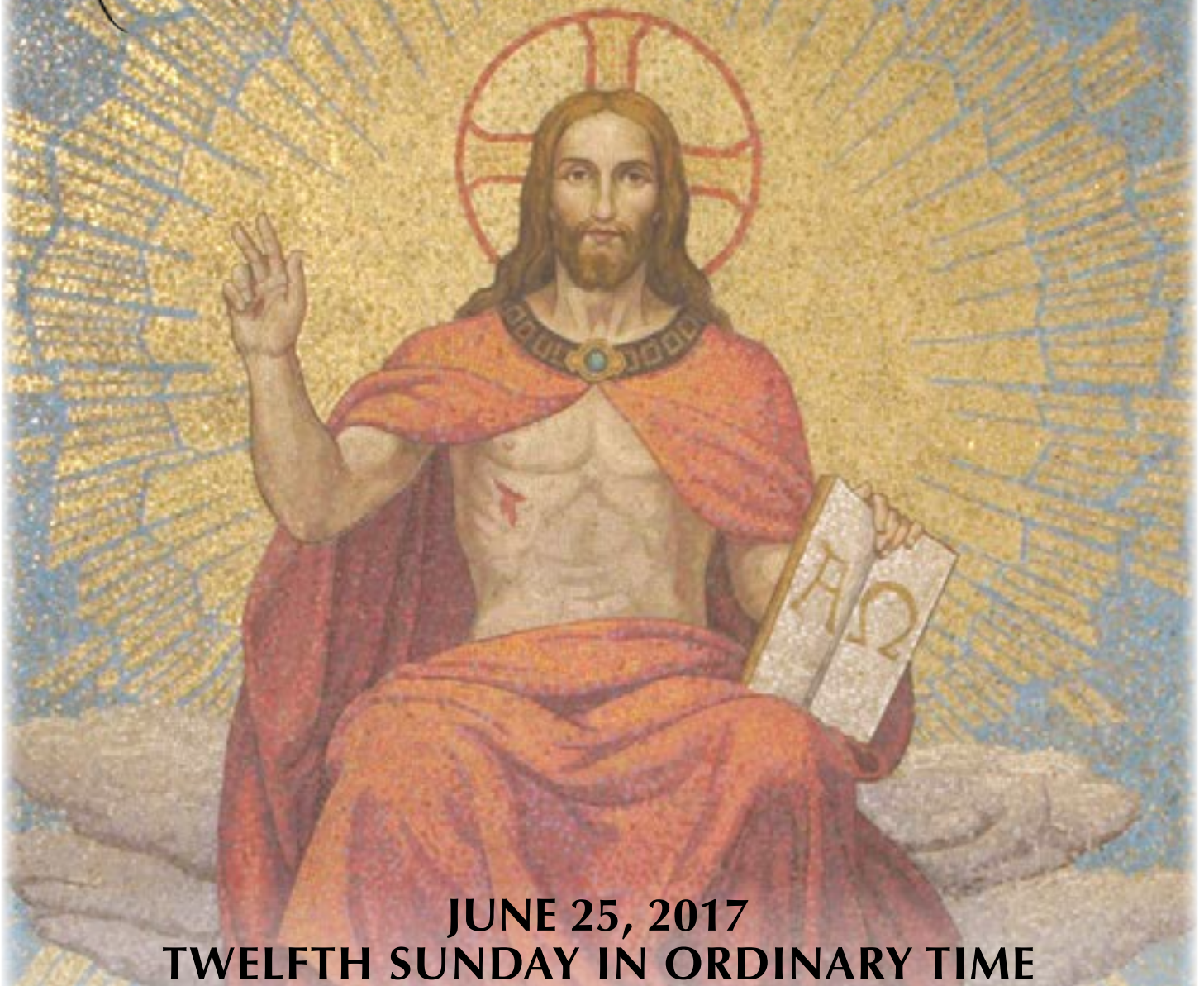

## LITURGY OF THE WORD

*In the Scriptures, God speaks to us, his people, in inspired words, opening to us the mystery of redemption and salvation and offering us spiritual nourishment. Christ himself is present in the midst of the faithful through his Word. As we are fed by the Word of God, we sit in attentive silence or offer our voices in song in full participation. We stand for the Gospel, showing great reverence for Jesus Christ present there, and finally we affirm the faith we have in the Creed before offering up our hearts to the Lord in our Universal Prayers.*

Jeremiah said: "I hear the whisperings of many: 'Terror on every side! Denounce! let us denounce him!' All those who were my friends are on the watch for any misstep of mine. 'Perhaps he will be trapped; then we can prevail, and take our vengeance on him.' But the LORD is with me, like a mighty champion: my persecutors will stumble, they will not triumph. In their failure they will be put to utter shame, to lasting, unforgettable confusion. O LORD of hosts, you who test the just, who probe mind and heart, let me witness the vengeance you take on them, for to you I have entrusted my cause. Sing to the LORD, praise the LORD, for he has rescued the life of the poor from the power of the wicked!"

**PASTORAL REFLECTION**

**We have all faced times when we have found it difficult to share our faith with others. We may be afraid of being criticized, teased, or even losing our job. It is difficult to face these pressures and fears alone. The courage to face them comes only from trust in God’s loving care.**

**In today’s gospel, Jesus sends his disciples on a mission to proclaim his message publicly. He warns them that they will face opposition, but tells them not to be afraid. He asks them and us to trust in God’s faithful care and attention. If God cares for even the smallest creatures in nature and the smallest details of our lives, God will certainly not abandon anyone who follows the way of Christ. God will give us the strength and courage to defend our faith in Jesus.**

**Jesus is present to us in a special way in this Eucharistic celebration. Let us ask him today for the strength and courage to give witness to our faith by our actions, our words, and our choices, by the way we live our lives.**
